

Subject: Selection procedure

Qualifying assumptions:

- research activity in the relevant field and publication of its results in scientific journals and scientific conferences of international importance,
- active English.

Information for applicants:

The basic monthly salary according to the regulations, depending on the length of the practice, is from 853 to 1,179.50 €. Depending on the scale and quality of the results achieved, the basic salary may be increased to twice. At FIIT, in 2017, the average monthly statutory salary including rewards and grants in this category was 1,552 €. A further increase in income is achieved through work on faculty projects in cooperation with industry.
