

## **Subject: Selection procedure**

# **Qualifying assumptions:**

Scientific-pedagogical title of Associate Professor in the relevant or related field of study.

### Other criteria:

- managerial skills and experience,
- third degree education in the required field, or in a related field,
- professional experience at least 5 years,
- research activity in the relevant field and publication of its results in scientific journals and scientific conferences of international importance,
- management of research teams,
- organizing international scientific events,
- active English.

The criteria were approved on 14 May 2014 and took effect on 1 October 2015.

Each candidate will submit a completed table of current habilitation criteria to the application form.

### Information for applicants:

The basic monthly salary according to the regulations, depending on the length of the practice, is from  $951 - 1,266 \in$ . Depending on the scale and quality of the results achieved, the basic salary may be increased to twice. At FIIT, in 2017, the average monthly statutory salary including rewards and grants in this category was 1,896 €. A further increase in income is achieved through work on faculty projects in cooperation with industry.

Applications must be submitted by **12 April 2018**, together with a CV, certified evidence of education, a certificate of professional practice, an overview of scientific research and publishing activities and a
